40 London Employers strike Silver in 2022 regional Defence Employer Recognition Scheme Awards

A RECORD number of London's employers have been honoured by the Ministry of Defence with top awards in this year's Defence Employer Recognition Scheme.

These awards recognise the outstanding support for our armed forces from employers across London. The Defence Employer Recognition Scheme acknowledges those organisations which actively demonstrate support to the armed forces community.

To gain the Silver ERS Award, organisations must have shown that they proactively demonstrated that service personnel and the wider armed forces community are not unfairly disadvantaged during their recruiting and selection processes. Also, actively ensuring that their workforce is aware of their positive policies towards defence people issues and demonstrated support to mobilisations or have a framework in place by providing at least five days' additional special leave. 40 of the companies were successful, a list of which can be found below.

The nominations were considered by a selection board at a regional level for silver, comprising of both military and civilian members.

Peter Germain, chief executive of the Reserve Forces' and Cadets' Association for Greater London, said:

"Regardless of size, location or sector, employing members of the Armed Forces community is good for businesses. These awards recognise the outstanding support for our Armed Forces from employers across the UK and I would like to thank and congratulate each and every one."
